The Grants Committee of the Foundation's Board of Trustees will review each submission and will select the most promising preliminary applications for further consideration. Selected applicants will be given the full application form to complete.

Only those individuals or organizations whose projects are thought to merit consideration will be asked to fill out a formal application. Ms. Rogers or an assigned member of the EHHF Grants Committee may assist applicants requesting help with completing the application should that be needed. Once granted, the selected project(s) must furnish periodic reports regarding the progress of the project.

### **Grant Application Chronology**

1. Preliminary applications in the form of a single paragraph should be submitted to Ms Rogers by March 15, 2012.
2. Completion date for full grant submission from selected applicants – May 15, 2012
3. Notification of awards will be made by June 30, 2012
